- a. Well Repair
 - i. Discussion Based on discussion, artesian well will not be economically feasible. A gravel pack well would be needed in this application. This type of well has better flow rates for water and requires less long term maintenance. Parks are still seeking exact quotes. The committee votes to change the previous allowance based on new information. Note this is still a #1 priority for Parks.

- ii. Motion to vote to approve capital expense not to exceed \$100,000-

- b. Shed Repair
 - Discussion No vote taken, but wanted to reiterate this ia a #1 Priority for Parks.
- c. Pavilion
 - Discussion Reviewed information with parks. Work is still needed to finalize exact scope prior to bid. Estimated budget for the project is \$80,000 based on construction, landscape, and outfitting. Note this is a #3 priority for Parks.

- d. Paving Sinkholes and Repair basketball court
 - i. Discussion Specific items have been separated out from paving scope for rest of town requests. This includes (1) crack repair on walking track and basketball court (budget \$4,000), and (2) repair of sinkhole in parking lot (budget \$6,000). Previously other submitted line items for paving have been removed from scope of capital expense. Note this is a #2 priority for Parks.
