

Dunstable Board of Selectmen

Meeting Minutes, Tuesday May 27 , 2014

Present: Chairman Daniel Devlin, Ken Leva, Walter Alterisio.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Devlin at 7:09 pm. The following summarizes areas discussed and actions taken.

Mr. Devlin called for reorganization of the Board. Mr. Alterisio nominated Mr. Devlin as Clerk and Mr. Leva as Procurement Officer and moved nominations be closed. Motion was seconded by Mr. Leva. Motion passed. Minutes to reflect a single vote in acclamation for Mr. Alterisio, Chairman, Mr. Leva Procurement Officer, and Mr. Devlin Clerk.

Mr. Alterisio assumed Chairmanship and congratulated Mr. Devlin and Mr. Leva on a challenging past year that required leadership at all levels and the town is better for their service. The coming year will have similar issues and the Board is committed to working with all disciplines to achieve positive solutions.

The board discussed the proposed Tennessee Gas Pipeline project and how it may affect the town. Not a lot of information is known and the board will work with other boards and communities to educate ourselves and arrive at a response as needed.

The board discussed a need to establish a joint meeting with Groton and the Regional School District and establish format and frequency for budget spending in the current year as well as program strategy for future years. Mr. Alterisio will attempt to contact the Groton Selectmen's office and the Superintendent directly.

The board discussed the summer meeting schedule and the need to review appointments for next meeting. At the very least those authorities who approve spending and decide issues on behalf of the town need to be in place by June 30 effective July 1, 2014.
