

Safe Pathways Committee
Meeting: 3/11/2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:17 PM by John Callahan.

The minutes of Jan. 14, 2015 were reviewed and accepted as read.

There is concern the Pathways Committee does not always have enough members to make a quorum. John will clarify with Julianna and Bruce if they wish to continue as members. Paul Dalida has been asked and agreed to join the committee.

Dianna and John attended the Conservation Committee meeting. The Highway Department has raised concerns regarding the curbing of the pathways related to water run-off and the ability to plow the roads properly. Paul stated that without curbing a level walkway above street level can't be maintained. In some instances there is no room between the walkway and the wall which affects drainage. Paul added that extending approximately 40 feet of curbing to facilitate drainage to the catch basin on 529 Main Street would eliminate the problem of improper run-off. Action: John will review these findings with Mike Martin of the Highway Dept as well as Joe Marsh who will report back to Pathway- Sidewalk Plan designed by Stamski and McNary.
