Massachusetts Chapter 140, Section 137 ALL DOGS 6 MONTHS OR OLDER MUST BE LICENSED

All dogs must be licensed annually. Per the Town of Dunstable Dog Control Bylaw, a \$10.00 late fee will be in effect for renewal licenses purchased after March 31, with an additional \$50.00 fine assessed after May 1. Failure to vaccinate against rabies by a licensed veterinarian shall result in a One Hundred dollar (\$100.00) fine pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws 140:145B.

It was voted at the Annual Town Meeting in May 2004 that the license fee would be waived for dog owners aged 70 and older (all other fees will apply such as a late fee). "Senior" refers to the age of the owner, not the dog.

If ordering my mail, send this application to the Office of the Town Clerk; enclose the fee payable to Town of Dunstable, with a **SELF-ADDRESSED**, **STAMPED ENVELOPE**. If a current rabies certificate is not on file with the Town Clerk's office, a copy must be enclosed with this application. A spay or neutering certificate must be enclosed if the dog has not previously been licensed as spayed or neutered.
