Review of potential warrant items for Special November 7th Town Meeting

- 1. Article to allocate \$2553.00 to pay unpaid bills.
- 2. Allocate \$24,000 to survey Simmons Property Donation for Public Safety building in town center.
 - i. Harrold abstained from input as he is related to the donor
 - b. Survey would include "geo-teching the building"
 - c. We spent large amount of time debating the merits of the building and usefulness of such a large survey project
 - d. Secondary benefit of survey would be the placement of a water department storage / mechanical need on rear part of land.
- 3. \$30,000.00 for the New England Police Bargaining Agreement (NEPBA).
 - a. This new collective bargaining agreement covers 7 Dunstable Police officers.
 - b. Exact language of the agreement is still being discussed and will be shared at a later date once ratified by the officers.
- 4. \$5,000.00 for an Actuary Consultant to review OPEB and the evaluation of Retirement health insurance for employees. Actuary would review financial consequences of town offering this health insurance coverage to employees.
 - a. Sizeable discussion about why this offering is needed. Feelings were mixed about the value it would provide to the town.
- 5. \$40,000.00 to replace town hall boiler that has failed. This is a critical item as the fall and winter are approaching. There is no heating in the town hall.
 - a. Previously replaced circulator pump (last year) will remain and continue to be functional.

Additional items for Special Town Meeting

- 1. Increase in Dog Fines for barking / bad behavior
- 2. Commercial overlay discussion and its usefulness to the town.
 - a. Leah brought forth the Historic Town Center classification as an effort to maintain the town center image and facades of buildings.
 - b. The motivation for the commercial overlay Dunstable's dry-town stipulation
 - c. Noise by-law for commercial overlay town center
 - i. Feasibility of this is still being reviewed
- 3. Town Hall is considering changing office hours for voter registration away from weekend hours.

- 4. Alexander Way completion of road and public approval to make roadway part of town.
- 5. Acceptance of land donation from Simmons's family (Public Safety building for Dunstable).

Miscellaneous items

Groton Dunstable Regional School District Cap Stabilization fund was discussed for funding projects for the schools.

- School items could be earmarked for approval
- We could also use debt exclusions and operations override in place of the Cap Stabilization fund.
