Meeting called to order at 6:02 p.m.

Town Administrator Update and Discussion

- 1. Proposed FY21 budget adjustments with new information since our last meeting.
 - 1.1. Swallow Union capital adjusted.
 - 1.2. GLTHS assessment was lower than expected, so the GLTHS excess was put toward the GDRSD assessment.
 - 1.3. State Aid increased by approximately \$4,000. \$2,000 was used to fund TADS and \$2,000 was put into the FinCom reserve account.
 - 1.4. Health insurance premiums are still under negotiation, but may only increase about 3.1% instead of the historical average of near 10%.
- 2. Police union CBA talks are progressing.
- 3. The Dunstable Trinity Ambulance service contract is up for renewal.
 - 3.1. The nearest Trinity Ambulance facility is in Chelmsford. A closer ambulance facility should reduce response time.
 - 3.2. Brian is reviewing options.
- 4. Public Hearing to review the ATM warrant planned for April 13th, 2020.
- 5. Next meeting scheduled for April 2nd.
- 6. Plan to use the AB town report and meeting minutes to demonstrate need and advocate for passage of a proposition $2\frac{1}{2}$ override.
- 7. Possibly create a proposition 2½ override support document outlining:
 - 7.1. When was the last override?
 - 7.2. Proposed override amount.
 - 7.3. A pie chart showing where we expect the money from this new override would be spent. FY21, FY22 ...
 - 7.4. What is the cost to me? What is the tax rate now, and what will it be with the override?
 - 7.5. Monthly and annual cost increase for a typical home.
