Cemetery Commission Minutes November 9, 2020 Dunstable Town Hall

Meeting called to order at 6:01.

New member, Susan Tully was welcomed to the Commission.

Four Lot Deeds were signed by the members and notarized by Jacob Voelker. Lots #66, 67,68 62 are all in Section D. Sue P. will complete recording these in the Deed Record Book and issuing them to the Owners within the next week. There was a brief discussion regarding the request from the DAR to install a brass marker on the grave of Anna Rydingsvard. There were no objections.

There were some suggestions made for updating the Regulations to address sizes allowed for monuments. There will be no electrical devices placed on graves and no pendants or flags other than those currently allowed. These include U.S. flags and military markers to distinguish graves of Veterans. Police or Fire Dept. flags will be allowed only when death occurred while on duty. There will be more discussion and finalization of these regs at the next meeting, after which Jake will post them on the Town website and new booklets will be printed out.

Ryan will complete a letter in support of the Rt 113 project including the Commission's concern that consideration be given to the age of the Cemetery wall and tombs along that side.

Minutes were passed for meetings on March 6, 2018, May 1, 2018 and September 30, 2020.

The next meeting will be on January 11, 2021 at 11 a.m. Place tba. Agenda will include Green Burials and possible new building using Proctor funds.
