# **O River Street/Unkety Brook Development**

The project for an 11 single-family cluster subdivision is proceeding as a MESA review by the state is in process. The new housing will take up 14 acres, with 72.5 acres going to MA Fish & Game.

# **Stewardship**

Applications for grants require documentation of what the Commission is doing with the land that is protected. Stewardship can include trail maintenance, walking boundaries documentation, signage, community education programs, etc. We have several fields which are regularly mowed to maintain as pasture and for wildlife habitat.
