Meeting Minutes – May 9, 2017

Juan made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 9^{th} meeting with a correction. Leah 2^{nd} the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

Bills/Payroll

A bill for mileage/parking and the Administrative Assistant's payroll were presented. Bill made a motion to sign both. Juan 2nd the motion. – Motion passed with Leah abstaining from the vote.

Forest Street – Ross Associates Site Visit

Leah, Bill, Alan and Jeff met Neil Gorman and his wetland specialist from Ross Associates at the site. Mr. Gorman had previously submitted a Notice of Intent omitting a ditch on the plans. The Commission made their determination based on the plan submitted. Since the writing of the Order of Conditions, members found that a plan submitted to the Planning Board showed a ditch. While on site it was confirmed that the ditch does in fact connect to the wetland on the property which makes it jurisdictional. Leah said that Mr. Gorman will be submitting a new plan showing the wetland and replication area. The Commission will vote to correct the Order of Conditions once the new plan has been provided.

Sky Meadow Earthwork

The Administrative Assistant called Sky Meadow to inquire about earthwork going on at the golf course. No return call was made.

265 Westford Street – Ditch

Alan went out to 265 Westford Street at the request of the Highway Department to assess the land in the front of the house. The resident said that water flows from the front of his house into his basement. He would like to contour the land to direct water away from the house. After walking the property with the owner, Alan told the owner that the area is not a wetland; therefore the Commission has no jurisdiction.
