## Planning Board Minutes Tuesday, January 3, 2023

Chair Jeff Pallis called the meeting to order at 6:30pm

### **Approval of Meeting Minutes of December 5, 2022**

Alan made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of the December 5th meeting, as submitted. Jim 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

### **Bills/Payroll**

- Joe made a motion to pay a Hoyle-Tanner invoice for special permit review services associated with 0 River Street/Unkety Brook development for \$949.25. Alan 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

- Joe made a motion to sign off on payrolls. Alan 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

#### Edge-of-Road By-law Proposal - Town Counsel's Reviewed Draft

Town counsel had reviewed and made some structural changes to the general bylaw draft presented previously by the Planning Board. Attorney Falk removed language intended to be educational in explaining rights-of-way to the public and noted such is best left to the town website. He added enforcement language and a penalty to compel



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enforcement which he noted the board was free to modify. The board discussed his \$100/day violation fine and agreed it was sufficient.

Alan made a motion to approve the latest edition of the proposed general bylaw and submit it as a warrant article to the Select Board for the spring annual town meeting. Joan 2nd the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.

Alan made a motion to close the meeting at 7:38pm. Jim 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. – Motion passed unanimously.
