HOW TO SAFELY TRANSPORT HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Leave materials in original containers
- Tighten caps and lids
- Sort and pack separately: oil paint, pesticides and household cleaners
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspapers
- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS
- NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous material
- ALL containers must be labeled label with sharpie if original label missing.
