Scope of Work:

The work under this contract consists of the reconstruction of various streets.

The work shall consist of scarifying and pulverizing the existing bituminous paved area and underlying material to form an asphaltic stabilized base and the removal and disposal of existing bituminous paved areas.

Qualifications:

It is the responsibility of each Contractor submitting proposals for the work to assure himself/herself that the equipment/construction methods he/she intends to use are capable of complying with project specifications. The attention of each Contractor submitting a Proposal is directed to that portion of the project specifications which require the Contractor to demonstrate to the Engineer the ability of his/her crew(s) and equipment to comply with the specifications requirements and to do so at a rate of production consistent with the time allowed under the contract.

In submitting proposals for this work, Contractors are required to identify specific equipment to be used on the project in *order to meet the project schedule*.

Time Periods:

The Contractor to whom the Contract is awarded shall be required to execute the Contract and furnish the insurance and bonds duly executed with a satisfactory surety company within five. (5) days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays of the date of the mailing of the notice to the bidder according to the address given by him/her, that the Contract is ready for execution.

The Contractor shall be required to start work within ten (10) days of receipt of a notice to proceed and shall complete all work in a timely fashion as determined by the Director of Public Services or his designee. Timely fashion shall be determined on a job specific basis by the Director of Public Services or his designer.

Construction Methods:

1) Tie Card Documentation/Submission

The Contractor will be responsible for measuring and maintaining swing tie records for all utility structures including, but not limited to, drain manholes, water gates, catch basins, gas gates/drip boxes, monitoring wells and telecommunication manholes.

A copy of the utility swing tie records shall be submitted to the Town of Dunstable Highway Department prior to the commencement of reclamation.

2) Lowering/Plating Structures

Contractor shall supply plates to protect all existing casting and structures.

- Any exposed catch basins shall be protected from sediment at all times.
- The Contractor shall protect all existing curb work. All existing pavement on side streets, driveways and limits of work shall be saw cut and protected from damage.

o) Road Surface Reclamation

The pavement area to be reclaimed shall be swept with a power sweeper to remove all sand, dirt, organic matter, and other unsuitable materials.

The Contractor shall reclaim only that area of pavement that can be processed and compacted by the end of the same working day. Reclaimed areas shall be acceptable for vehicular traffic at the end of each working day.

The existing road pavement shall be scarified and mixed with an equal amount of the gravel base existing in the roadway foundation. The mixture of scarified pavement and equal amount of gravel base shall be crushed simultaneously by rotating drum so that the friction heat generated from the crushing operation will allow the asphalt content of scarified pavement to coat the fines of the virgin base. This simultaneous crushing must blend the asphalt and gravel fines into a homogenous mass, utilizing the asphalt acquired from the existing pavement as a stabilizer which bonds the materials together when compacted. The crushed material shall pass the 3-inch sieve and meet the following gradation:

The method used shall ensure that the entire mass of material so worked shall be uniformly graded to these specifications. If additional fines are required, the Contractor will be directed to add material, furnished by others, or he/she may add material directly from the existing roadway foundation with approval of the Engineer, but scarified pavement and gravel fines must be crushed together. After the material has

been thoroughly worked together as described in the above paragraph, it shall be shaped and graded as directed by the Engineer.

4) Rough Grading

Before surfacing or sub-base is spread, the subgrade shall be shaped to a true surface conforming to the proposed cross section of the highway and compacted in accordance with the provisions of MassDOT Specifications Subsections 150.60 and 150.62.

5) Excess Material Removal & Fine Grading

All depressions and high spots shall be filled with suitable material or removed and such areas again compacted until the surface is smooth and satisfactorily compacted. A tolerance of ½ inch above or below the finished subgrade will be allowed provided that this ½ inch above or below grade is not maintained for a distance longer than 50 feet and that the required crown is maintained in the subgrade.

6) Compaction

Water shall be applied during the entire operation to ensure the optimum moisture content at time of compaction.

The restored cross-section shall be thoroughly compacted to a dense consolidated mass by rolling with a steel wheel roller weighing not less than fourteen (14) tons. The required density, as approved by the Engineer, shall be determined by the number of passes of said rollers to produce the maximum and uniform density throughout the entire area of the work to be done under this item as established upon a test area at the job site by the sand volume method or a nuclear device. Any portion of the subgrade that is not accessible to a roller shall be thoroughly compacted with the mechanical tampers or by other adequate methods approved as satisfactory by the Town. The Contractor, as soon as practical, shall prepare a test section area to enable the Engineer to conduct the necessary tests. An application of calcium chloride of .25 gallons per square yard shall be applied after the reclaimed base material is fine graded, and prior to the paving or as requested by the Board of Road Commissioners or his designer. The calcium chloride solution shall be provided by the manufacturer as a true solution and shall not be reconstructed from flake calcium chloride. Maintenance and protection of traffic, dust control and daily clean-up throughout the project area shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

7) Final Cleanup

Upon completion of the work and before acceptance and final pavement, the Contractor shall remove and dispose in an approved manner, at his own expense, from the right-of-way, construction site, dredging site, and adjoining property; all temporary structures and all surplus materials and rubbish which the Contractor may have accumulated during the prosecution of work, and shall leave the areas in a neat and orderly condition.

No equipment or material shall be left within any of the aforementioned areas after acceptance of the Contract without the written permission of the Engineer. The Contractor shall not abandon any material at or near the site regardless of whether or not it has any value.

Provisions for Travel and Prosecution of Work:

If found to be necessary, the road shall be constructed one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) width at a time to allow for passage of through traffic. Access to the property of abutters is to be provided as necessary.

Utilities:

The Contractor shall contact the respective utility company and must be exceedingly careful not to disturb or break existing manholes, catch basins, valve boxes and other castings which may be located in the surface of the road.

Special Provisions:

The Town will do all clearing and grubbing, drainage, reset signs, mailboxes, guardrails, and furnish traffic police as required.

Line and grading stakes will be furnished by the Contractor.

This insurance shall be written by a company licensed to do business in the state of Massachusetts with a minimum A.M. Best rating of A- VII. Each policy shall provide for written notification to the Town at least thirty (30) days prior to termination, material change or restrictive amendments. The coverage's and limits are to be considered minimum requirements under this contract and in no way limit the liability of the Contractor.
- 7. <u>Standard of Performance</u>: The work performed under this Contract shall be rendered in conformity with the standards of the trade and shall be professional and of the highest fabrication and installation quality in all respects. Substandard fabrication and installation quality shall be deemed a breach of this Contract.
- 8. <u>Safety Standards</u>: The Contractor acknowledges that the Project involves public property. The Contractor shall provide protection to members of the public at all times while performing work on the Project in accordance with OSHA regulations, and shall contact the Town's Police Department if any public safety details protection may be necessary.

9. Guarantees:

- a. The Contractor guarantees the work under this Contract and the materials furnished by it for use in connection therewith to be free from defects or flaws for one year after the completion of the Contract. It is expressly understood, however, that this guarantee provision shall not absolve the Contractor from any liability to the Town arising out of a failure to substantially comply with the terms of the Contract.
- b. If at any time within said guaranty period, any part of the work constructed under the terms of this Contract shall in the opinion of the Town require repair due to defective work or materials furnished by the Contractor, the Town may notify the Contractor in writing to make the required repairs. If the Contractor shall neglect to start such repairs within ten days of the date of receipt of notice thereof and to complete the same to the satisfaction of the Town with reasonable dispatch, then the Town may employ other persons to make such repairs. The Town shall charge the expense thereof to the Contractor and may use any moneys still retained to pay for the same, and if such sum is insufficient, the Contractor shall be obligated to pay the balance thereof.
- 10. <u>Indemnification</u>: Notwithstanding the availability and policy limits of any insurance, the Contractor hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless, including attorneys fees, the Town, its officers and employees ("Indemnified Parties") against any claims made or legal actions brought against an Indemnified Party(ies) by any person or entity as a result of or arising from injuries, damages, expenses and losses actually or allegedly incurred by such a person or entity ("Liabilities") arising out of or relating to the Contractor's performance or failure to perform pursuant to this Contract, except where the Liabilities are the result of the Indemnified Party's own direct and sole negligence. This obligation shall survive the termination, completion or expiration of this Contract. The Contractor shall promptly notify the Town of any claim or action brought in connection with this Contract and thereupon shall promptly take over and defend any such claim or action.
- 11. Payment Bond: The Contractor shall obtain and deposit with the Town a Payment Bond equal to [fifty/one hundred] percent (50%/100%)] of the total contract amount on a form prescribed by the Town. [AT LEAST 50% REQUIRED IF COST OVER \$25K]

12. Remedies of the Town:

a. If the Contractor shall provide services in a manner which are not to the satisfaction of the Town, the Town may request that the Contractor redo the work at no additional cost to the Town until approved by the Town. If the Contractor shall fail to provide such services or shall provide services which are not satisfactory to the Town, in the alternative, may make any reasonable purchase or contract to purchase services in substitution of those due from the Contractor. The Town may deduct the cost of any substitute contract or nonperformance of services together with incidental and consequential damages from the contract price and shall withhold such damages from sums due to become due. If after reasonable effort, the Town is unable to make any reasonable purchase or contract in substitution thereof, the Town may require the Contractor to deliver all completed work to date.

- b. If the damages sustained by the Town as determined by the Town exceed sums due or to become due, the Contractor shall pay the difference to the Town upon demand.
- 13. <u>Post-Completion</u>: Upon the completion of the Project, the Contractor shall at his own expense remove all equipment, temporary Contractor's buildings and sheds, fencing, rubbish and waste material in and about the area that has been worked and he shall leave the premises and the work performed all in a neat and proper condition.
- 14. <u>Schedule</u>: Before commencing the Project, the Contractor shall, if required, submit a schedule of operations for approval by the Town. The schedule shall show the methods and order of operations that the Contractor proposes to use. The approval of the schedule by the Town shall not be construed as relieving the Contractor from any responsibility.
- 15. <u>Unanticipated Delay</u>: Should the Contractor be obstructed or delayed in the prosecution of the work by any act or neglect on the part of the Town, or as a result of damage which may be caused by lightning, earthquake, rain, storm, or cyclone, then the time fixed for completion may be extended for a period equivalent to the time lost by reason of any of the foregoing causes. No such extension shall be made unless a claim therefor is presented in writing to the Town within forty-eight hours of the occurrence of such delay. The Contractor shall have no claim against the Town for damages on account of such delay. The duration of the extension itself must be certified in writing by the Town.
- 16. <u>The Contract Documents</u>: The following, together with this Contract, form the Contract and all are as fully a part of the Contract as if attached to this Contract or herein repeated: the Advertisement of the Invitation for Bids, the Bidding Documents, including the Contractor's completed Bid Form, the Contract Forms, the Statutory Provisions for Public Construction in Massachusetts (attached as <u>Exhibit B</u>) and the plans and specifications attached as <u>Exhibit A</u>.

17. Termination:

a. If the Contractor shall be adjudged a bankrupt, or if he shall make a general assignment for the benefit of his creditors, or if a receiver of his property shall be appointed, or if the work to be done under the Contract shall be abandoned, or if the Contract or any part thereof shall be sublet without the previous written consent of the Town, or if the Contract or any claim thereunder shall be assigned by the Contractor otherwise than as herein specified, or if at any time the Town's Town Manager shall be of the opinion that the work, or any part thereof, is unnecessarily or unreasonably delayed, or that the Contractor has violated any of the provisions of the Contract, the Town's Town Manager, for and in behalf of the Town, may notify the Contractor to discontinue all work, or any part thereof; and thereupon the Contractor shall discontinue such work or such part thereof as the Town's Town Manager may designate, remove his equipment, tools, supplies and materials as the Town's Town Manager directs, and the Town may thereupon, by contract or otherwise, as it may determine, complete the work, or such part thereof, and charge the entire expense of so completing the work or any part thereof to the Contractor.

- b. If the Town's Town Manager shall certify by written notice to the Contractor that the rate of progress is not satisfactory, the Town may, instead of notifying the Contractor to discontinue all of the work or any part thereof, notify him from time to time to increase the force, equipment and plant, or any of them, employed on the whole or any part of the work, stating the amount of increase required. Unless the Contractor shall, within five days after such notice, increase his force, equipment and plant to the extent required therein, and maintain and employ the same from day to day until the completion of the work or such part thereof, or until the conditions of the work or such part thereof, or until the conditions as to the rate of progress shall, in the opinion of the Town's Town Manager, be fulfilled, the Town may employ and direct the labors of such additional force, equipment and plant as may, in the opinion of the Town's Town Manager, be necessary to insure the completion of the work or such part thereof within the time specified or at the earliest possible date thereafter, and charge the expense thereof to the Contractor. Neither the notice from the Town's Town Manager to the Contractor to increase his force, equipment or plant nor the employment of additional force, equipment or plant by the Town shall be held to prevent a subsequent notice to the Contractor from the Town to discontinue the work under the provisions of the preceding portion of this section.
- c. All expenses charged under this section shall be deducted by the Town out of moneys then due or to become due the Contractor under this Contract, or any part thereof. In such accounting the Town shall not be obligated to obtain the lowest figures for the work of completed the Contract or any part thereof, or for insuring its proper completion, and all sums actually paid by the Town shall be charged to the Contractor. If the expense so charged is greater than the sum which would have been payable under the Contract, if the same had been completed by the Contractor, then the Contractor shall pay the amount of the excess to the Town upon completion of the work and without further demand being made therefor.
- d. This contract may be terminated at any time for the convenience of the Town at the option of the Town by delivering or mailing to the Contractor at the Contractor's business address a written notice of termination setting forth the date, not less than seven (7) days after the date of such delivery or mailing; when such termination for convenience occurs, the Contractor shall be compensated for all services rendered to the effective date of said termination in accordance with the rates of compensation specified in this contract.
- e. The Contractor shall not be relieved of liability to the Town by virtue of any termination of this Contract and any claim for damages against the Contractor relating to the Contractor's performance under this Contract shall survive any termination hereunder.
- 18. <u>Authority to Authorize Change Orders and Adjustments</u>: The Contractor shall perform all the work required in conformity with the plans and specifications provided by the Town. This Contract may be amended only by a written Change Order, mutually agreed upon and duly executed by the parties hereto. No modifications, waiver or alternation of the Contract or any term herein shall be enforceable unless it is in writing, as a Change Order, and duly

- executed by both the Town and the Contractor. An executed Change Order shall constitute a final settlement of all matters relating to the change in the work that is the subject of the Change Order.
- 19. <u>Assignment</u>: The Contractor shall not assign, subcontract, or in any way transfer any interest in this Contract without the prior written consent of the Town.
- 20. <u>Massachusetts Law</u>: This Contract shall be construed in accordance with and shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Wherever applicable law mandates the inclusion of any term into a contract for the Project, this Contract shall be deemed to include such term or. To whatever extent any provision of this Contract shall be inconsistent with any law or regulation limiting the power or liability of cities, towns and/or Towns, such law or regulation shall control.
- 21. <u>Prevailing Wages</u>: This Contract is subject to the Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Statute, M.G.L. c. 149, § 27 and the Contractor shall pay applicable wages as set forth in the schedule of wages included in the Bidding Documents.
- 22. <u>REAP Certification</u>: Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 62C, § 49A, the individual signing this Contract on behalf of the Contractor certifies, under the penalties of perjury, that, to the best of his/her knowledge and belief, the Contractor has complied with all laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts relating to taxes, reporting of employees and contractors, and withholding and remitting child support.
- 23. <u>Conflict of Interest</u>: The Contractor's attention is called to M.G.L. c. 268A. The Contractor shall not act in collusion with any Town officer, agent, employee, or any party regarding this Contract, nor shall the Contractor make gifts regarding this Contract or any other matter in which the Town has a direct or substantial interest.
- 24. <u>Independent Contractor</u>: The Town and the Contractor intend that the relationship established between them pursuant to this Contract shall be that of client and independent contractor. No agent, employee, or servant of the Contractor shall be or shall be deemed to be an employee, agent or servant of the Town. For the limited purposes of M.G.L. c. 268A, the Contractor shall be considered a "municipal employee."
- 25. <u>Liability of Public Officials</u>: To the full extent permitted by law, no official, employee, agent or representative of the Town shall be individually or personally liable on any obligation of the Town under this contract.
- 26. Notices: All notices under this Contract shall be in writing and shall be deemed received (i) upon delivery in hand, (ii) one business day after being sent by reputable overnight delivery or courier service providing for receipted delivery, or (iii) two business days after being sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, or (iv) the same business day after being sent by facsimile with confirmation of receipt; and addressed as follows:

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, the awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. The updated wage schedule must be provided to all contractors, including general and sub-contractors, working on the construction project.
- This annual update requirement is generally not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts. For such contracts, the prevailing wage rates issued by DLS shall remain in effect for the duration of the contract term. However, if the prevailing wage rate sheet issued does not contain wage rates for each year covered by the contract term, the Awarding Authority must request updated rate sheets from DLS and provide them to the contractor to ensure the correct rates are being paid throughout the duration of the contract. Additionally, if an Awarding Authority exercises an option to renew or extend the contract term, they must request updated rate sheets form DLS and provide them to the contractor.
- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or a sub-contractor.
- Apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS). Apprentices must keep their apprentice identification card on their persons during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DAS regardless of whether they are registered with another federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate.
- Every contractor or subcontractor working on the construction project must submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. For a sample payroll reporting form go to http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Contractors must obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities. Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may file a complaint with the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.

Minimum wage rates for apprentices employed on public works projects are listed above as a percentage of the hourly prevailing wage rate established by the Commissioner under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 149, §§ 26-27D. Apprentice ratios are established by DAS pursuant to M.G.L. c. 23, §§ 11E-11L. Ratios are expressed as the allowable number of apprentices to journeymen or fraction thereof, unless otherwise specified. The ratios listed herein have been taken from relevant private collective bargaining agreements (CBAs) and are provided for illustrative purposes only. They have not been independently verified as being accurate or continuing to be accurate. Parties having questions regarding what ratio to use should contact DAS.

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
