



## Housing Production Plan Update



Town of Dunstable Housing Production Plan Public Meeting

The Town of Dunstable is working to update our **Housing Production Plan**, which will recommend actions we should take for the next five years. Its goal is to improve housing affordability and tackle challenges such as the following:

> 241 Dunstable households — 22% of all households — pay 30% or more of their income on housing

The median Dunstable home cost \$719,000 in 2022, putting nome ownership out of reach for many households.

Elders have increased as a proportion of total households from 12% to 25% in 2017-2021, but appropriate homes are inaccessible
