What's Going on in Dunstable?

The goal of this newsletter is to share information from the town's municipal departments as well as volunteer boards & committees. Please note, that some information could be subject to changes.

Summer 2022

1. Route 113 Highway Project

• Route 113 project is active even through the warmest summer days. Construction around town center and Westford / Hillcrest Streets will continue. Stone wall work on the wetlands side of Rt. 113 is coming together to help increase roadway width and stability. Road cuts are happening as a regular occurrence with the installation of new electrical poles, other utilities, and grade alterations. Currently this project is going according to schedule but please continue to be patient with traffic delays, road detours, and reduced access to the town. Construction workers and police officers are working to guide traffic.

2. Larter Field Irrigation

Larter Field Irrigation has been reactivated. The Parks and Recreation group have been
working tirelessly to get the water on the field(s) again. Each morning the system is
working to get parts of the field green again. A larger discussion on well viability is likely
to be addressed in a thorough review process by the committee and experts in the field
for potential next steps. More info is to follow.

3. Dunstable Fire Department:

Dunstable Fire Department has narrowed down its pool of potential Chief candidates.
 The Selectmen have interviewed candidates and are reviewing next steps for a potential hire. We hope to come to an agreement on a new hire soon.

4. MUD/Affordable Housing Project

The RFP received two responses for the MUD / Affordable Housing project. The
Affordable Housing Committee is working through its project criteria to determine next
steps. Criteria aspects were defined by the group to find a developer that can
accommodate size, scope, character of Dunstable to help us achieve the most impactful
benefits to Dunstable.

5. SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION – JULY 19, 2022 – Election Results

Dunstable held a special election on July 19, 2022. 367 Registered voters cast a ballot in
this special election. The question being asked was related to Town of Dunstable being
allowed to assess an additional \$188,974 in real estate and personal property taxes for
the purposes of paying for capital expenses in relation to the Groton-Dunstable Regional

School District. This vote *passed* to support the Schedule of Capital Improvements on file with the Dunstable Town Clerk for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022. Official election results are available here - https://www.dunstable-ma.gov/home/news/official-special-town-election-results.

6. Gas Line Utility Work

Work is happening on Hall Street with the construction of a natural gas line. Boston Gas
