

## **Errata Sheet for Dunstable Charter Revision #5**

Note: all changes noted in Errata sheet for charter revision #4 have been incorporated into the text of revision #5 as approved by the Committee and noted below in red.

1. Article 2, Legislative Branch, Section 2-3 Committees, para. a. – wording is added to the end of the paragraph to require that all appointees to committees be residents of Dunstable. **This language is incorporated into Rev. #5**
2. Article 3, Elected Officers, Section 3-2 Board of Selectmen, para. c. – wording is added to the end of the paragraph to require that all appointees to committees be residents of Dunstable. **The Committee declined to incorporate this language into the Charter so it has been deleted in Rev. #5 The Committee voted to strike the words “various trustees of trusts” and substitute therefor the words “Commissioners of Trust Funds”, which now appears in Rev. #5**
3. Article 3, Elected Officers, Section 3-3 Town Moderator, para. c. - wording is added to the end of the paragraph to require that all appointees to committees be residents of Dunstable. **This language is incorporated into Rev. #5.**
4. Article 4, Town Administrator, Section 4-2 Responsibilities and Duties, para. g – wording is added to exempt Conservation Commission properties from control of the Town Administrator. **This language is incorporated into Rev. #5.**
5. Article 5, Administrative Organization, Section 5-1 Organization of Town Agencies, para. b. – wording is added to make the exercise of the Town Administrator’s authority in this section subject to the approval of the Board of Selectmen. **This language is incorporated into rev. #5.**
6. Article 5, Administrative Organization, Section 5-6 Department of Public Works, para. a – wording is added to create a Public Works Advisory Board. **The Committee did not make a final decision regarding this language so it is still appears in Rev. #5.**
